Did you know...

- * Every year, sudden cardiac arrest kills twice as many people as colon cancer, breast cancer, and prostate cancer COMBINED.
- * According to the American Heart Association, when a person suffers a heart attack (sudden Cardiac Arrest), the person's chance of survival decreases by 7% to 10% for EACH MINUTE that passes without defibrillation; and with defibrillation given in the first minute after Cardiac Arrest, the survival rate can be as high as 90%.
- * The greatest risk for Cardiac Arrest is among men over 45 and women over 55 years of age, as well as among persons who smoke, are overweight, or have diabetes.
- * In 2014, the State of New Jersey will require that all educational facilities have access to and know how to use an Automatic External Defibrillator. **Janet's Law** also mandates that schools "shall establish and implement an emergency action plan for responding to a sudden cardiac event including, but not limited to, an event in which the use of an automated external defibrillator may be necessary."



What we will do...

CESTA's cost effective, comprehensive program includes:

1. Provide an up-to-date Automatic External Defibrillator (AED), approved by the FDA.
2. Maintain and test according to the manufacturer's operational guidelines.
3. Notification of machine location to your local Emergency Medical Service or ambulance provider.
4. On-site mounting.
5. Replace pads and batteries following use or expiration within 24 hours.
6. Initial Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automatic External Defibrillator (CPR/AED) 2 year certification for up to 7 employees through either the American Heart Association or another NJ recognized CPR/AED program.
7. Provide ventilation device for use initiating CPR. (BVM or pocket face mask)
8. Replacement of AED if warranted.
9. Recertification of CPR/AED training at the end of certification period.
10. Medical Direction

Completely compliant with Janet's Law without worry or hassle!
